DIGEST: Plaquemines Parish Government currently has a lease with Bridgette's Barber Shop for the usage of the South Parking area at the Popich Building used for customer parking. This Lease will need to transfer to the Port. *The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.*

WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District purchased the Popich Building from Plaquemines Parish Government; and

WHEREAS, the Parish Government currently has a lease agreement with Bridgette's Barber Shop to lease the South Parking Area at the Popich Building;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR AND TERMINAL DISTRICT THAT:

SECTION 1

Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement with Bridgette's Barber Shop for the usage of the South Parking area of the Popich Building located at 8056 Highway 23 Belle Chasse, LA.

SECTION 2

The Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release this Ordinance and that Parish employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.

Commissioner McCarty seconded the motion to adopt the Ordinance.

Under Agenda Item 7a(1) & 7a(2), Commissioner Champagne offered A Motion to Suspend the Rules to add "A Resolution amend and is amended Resolution 23-314, that approved the Insurance for the Plaquemines Port Harbor & Terminal District for all departments; Port Assets for 2024; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto."; A Resolution of the Plaquemines Parish Council, acting as the sole governing authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District, authorizing and directing special counsel Dannie P. Garrett, III to seek rehearing of the opinion of the First Circuit Court of Appeals, in the matter of Plaquemines Port, Harbor, and Terminal District versus State of Louisiana, DOTD, and Plenary, Docket No. 2024 CA 0099; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto." to today's agenda for consideration. The Motion was seconded by Commissioner Schulz and on roll call all members present and voting "YES", the motion was adopted by a vote of 9-0.

DIGEST: The Port purchased the Popich building from Plaquemines Parish Government. The insurance for this building was not included in our original insurance quotes and needs to be added to our policy. The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.

WHEREAS, the best quotes were received and reviewed for the Port's insurance needs and it is the recommendation of the Executive Director of the Port that the Council authorize the acceptance of the insurance coverage for the Popich Building;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE SOLE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR & TERMINAL DISTRICT THAT it hereby authorizes the acceptance of the quote of: Lloyd's Underwriters for Commercial Property insurance at a cost of \$23,968.71, and LA Citizens Property Insurance Corporation_at a cost of \$36,779.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE SOLE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT HARBOR & TERMINAL DISTRICT THAT the Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release this Resolution and that Port employees and officials are authorized to carry out, he purposes of this Resolution, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.

RESOLUTION NO. 24-288

On motion of Commissioner Champagne, seconded by Commissioner Schulz, and on roll call all members present and voting "YES", the following Resolution was adopted:

A Resolution of the Plaquemines Parish Council, acting as the sole governing authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District, authorizing and directing special counsel Dannie P. Garrett, III to seek rehearing of the opinion of the First Circuit Court of Appeals, in the matter of Plaquemines Port, Harbor, and Terminal District versus State of Louisiana, DOTD, and Plenary, Docket No. 2024 CA 0099; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

DIGEST: To direct special counsel to seek rehearing from the ruling of the Court of Appeals on the Belle Chasse Bridge Project litigation. The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.

WHEREAS, the Council, serving as the sole governing authority of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District (PPHTD) authorized litigation challenging the validity of the contract between the State of Louisiana, DOTD, and Plenary, under which Plenary would construct a new Belle Chasse Bridge, decommission the existing bridge and tunnel, operate and administer a tolling system on the bridge, and maintain the bridge during the term of the tolling; and

WHEREAS, that cause of action was filed on May 10, 2023 as: Plaquemines Port, Harbor, and Terminal District versus State of Louisiana, DOTD, and Plenary Infrastructure Belle Chasse, LLC, Docket No, 731886, Section 31, 19th Judicial District Court, Parish of East Baton Rouge, State of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Defendants filed various exceptions, including a Peremptory Exception of Prescription in the matter; and

WHEREAS, the Trial Court held a hearing on October 11, 2023 at which time the Peremptory Exception of Prescription was sustained, dismissing the cause of action with prejudice, and the Defendants withdrew all other pending exceptions, including the DOTD Exception of Mootness; and

WHEREAS, the PPHTD appealed the Trial Court Ruling to the First Circuit Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2024 the First Circuit Court of Appeals issued a ruling in which it held that the cause of action was moot, citing that the construction of the new bridge was almost completed, but did not rule on any of the issue of prescription, which was the subject of the Trial Court ruling being appealed; and

WHEREAS, there lies the potential to request the First Circuit Court of Appeals to consider rehearing this matter on the grounds that the issue of mootness was withdrawn by DOTD at the Trial Court, thus there was no argument or evidence taken thereon, nor was the issue briefed by either party; and

WHEREAS, the deadline to seek a rehearing is 14 days for notice of the Court of Appeal Ruling, which is October 4, 2024, which makes this Resolution time sensitive;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL, AS THE SOLE GOVERNING AUTHORITY FOR THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR AND TERMINAL DISTRICT THAT, Special counsel Dannie P. Garrett, III is hereby authorized and directed to seek a rehearing of the matter of Plaquemines Port, Harbor, and Terminal District versus State of Louisiana, DOTD, and Plenary, Docket No. 2024 CA 0099, First Circuit Court of Appeals, State of Louisiana.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE SOLE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR & TERMINAL

DISTRICT THAT the Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release this Resolution and that Parish employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes of this Resolution, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.
